WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

Level 2 First Extended Certificate in Art & Design

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course offers you the chance to experience a wide range of Art & Design principles and techniques in drawing, painting, photography and graphic design. This course is very hands-on and will help you to develop and unlock your creative potential whilst honing your design skills. You will be introduced to specialist equipment and software to help you succeed and progress to Level 3 courses in the Creative Industries.

UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

- Introduction to specialist pathways
- Developing an art and design portfolio
- Visual arts briefs
- Graphic design and photography briefs
- English and Maths (if not already achieved at GCSE grade 9-4/A*-C)

TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

You will be assessed across 4 areas: Skills Development, Art and Design Project, Personal Development, Responding to Creative Brief.

EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

It will be essential to have the following equipment such as pencils, brushes, pens, rubbers, rulers, scissors etc. It would be desirable to equip yourself with a materials art box. A materials list will be provided at enrolment.
