The primary outcome of the VTCT Level 2 Certificate in Women's Hairdressing is to prepare you to enter the specific sector of hairdressing as a junior hairdresser/stylist. All the units in this qualification relate directly to the specific job role of a junior hairdresser/stylist.

- Client consultation for hair services
- Follow health and safety practice in the salon
- Working in the hair industry
- Cut women's hair
- Shampoo and condition the hair and scalp

Optional units include:

- Colour and lighten hair
- Display stock to promote sales in a salon
- The art of colouring hair

WHERE CAN IT LEAD?

COURSE FEE:

£1,645 Full Fee.
