EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

- 2 Bunches Sunflowers approx. 8 stems (supermarket)
- Approx. 7 large Ivy leaves size of palm hand or similar from garden or Florists
- Hard Ruscus from florists or similar from garden, Euonymus, x 3 stems
- Round Terracotta or Ceramic container approx 18cm high x 16cm wide
- Floral foam included in course fee
- Large wide bag to take design home (Ikea bag ideally)
- · Please bring pen, note pad and sharp scissors
