Award, Introductory Certificate or Certificate in Learning, Employability and Progression (LEAP). Maths and English Functional skills at the appropriate level or GCSE will also be included.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The LEAP course focuses on developing confidence and employability skills, with opportunities for volunteering, enterprise projects, and work experience. Students will benefit from close pastoral support and a tutorial programme designed to build their personal and social skills.
