

VENUE AND DURATION OF COURSE:

John Ruskin College, Selsdon Park Road, South Croydon, CR2 8JJ, 1 year full-time.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Carpentry & Joinery Level 1 Diploma and GCSE grade 9-3 (A*-D) in English and Maths

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

City and Guilds Carpentry Level 2 Diploma.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

After learning the basic skills at Level 1, you can follow one of two routes:

- Site carpenters will work on building sites erecting and fitting timber.
- Bench carpenters will manufacture items such as roof trusses and staircases ready to be delivered to the building site to be installed by the site carpenters.

UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

- First fix flooring and roofing, frames, partitions and stairs
- Carrying out second fixing operations
- Carrying out carpentry maintenance Bench joinery
- Produce and mark out from setting out details for bench joinery products
- Manufacture bench joinery products

TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

Online City & Guilds tests and a portfolio of evidence.

EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

All students will be required to wear college uniform. Steel toe capped boots must be worn at all time when in the workshops.

WHERE CAN IT LEAD?

Students who complete this course may further their studies on a Construction Level 3 Apprenticeship.

COURSE FEE:

If you are under 19 on 31/08/2024, tuition is free. If you are 19 or over, please consult Client Services for advice and guidance on funding and eligibility.

You will need to purchase uniform items such as polo shirt, trousers and other personal protection equipment (PPE). Please be aware that there may be additional costs for equipment and educational visits. This information will be available from the curriculum staff at interview.
