

### VENUE AND DURATION OF COURSE:

John Ruskin College, Selsdon Park Road, South Croydon, CR2 8JJ, 2 years full-time.

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Four GCSE grade 9-1 (A\*-F) including English and Maths.

### WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

ICT Level 1 BTEC Level 1 Introductory qualifications in IT.

### COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The skills that you will develop on this course will assist you to move into a job in an office environment. This qualification introduces basic ICT practices and gives students a full breadth of essential ICT knowledge. Additionally, this course will provide the starting knowledge for entry to employment.

### UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

The BTEC Level 1 Introductory qualifications in IT consist of four core units and six optional units that provide a total of 360 Guided Learning Hours (GLH). You will be required to undertake GCSE retakes in English & Maths or Functional Skills Level 1, if you have not yet achieved grade 9-4 (A\*-C) in these areas. Students will also participate in work experience or a work-based project during non-college days.

#### Core Units:

- Unit A1 - Being Organised (30 GLH)
- Unit A2 - Developing a Personal Progression Plan (30 GLH)
- Unit A3 - Working with Others (30 GLH)
- Unit A3 - Researching a Topic (30 GLH)

#### Optional Units from the following list (6 UNITS):

- Unit IT5 - Developing Digital Information Using IT (40 GLH)
- Unit IT6 - Using Digital Communication Technologies (40 GLH)
- Unit IT7- Solving Technical IT Problems (40 GLH)
- Unit IT8 - Creating a Spreadsheet to Solve Problems (40 GLH)
- Unit IT9 - Creating a Website (40 GLH)
- Unit IT10 - Creating a Computer Program (40 GLH)
- Unit IT11 - Developing a Digital Product (40 GLH)
- Unit IT12 - Creating a Digital Animated Graphic (40 GLH)

N.B.: Optional units are subject to change.

**TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:**

The course is continuously assessed through assignments, practical project tasks and case studies. In some subjects, there will also be written and/or verbal tests. You will develop a responsible and co-operative approach to working on your own and in groups. The course uses practical activities, presentations and involvement with local business wherever possible.
